

## Official Inpatient Coding Guidelines

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ICD-10-PCS Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting and Human Services (DHHS) provide the following guidelines for coding and reporting using the International Classification of Diseases, th Revision, Clinical Modification (ICD-10-10CM). These guidelines should be used as a companion document to the official version of the ICD-10-CM as published on the NCHS website.

Coding | CMS  
The ICD-10-CM Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting identify which codes may be assigned as principal or first-listed diagnosis only, secondary diagnosis only, or principal/first-listed or secondary (depending on the circumstances).

Coding "Probable" diagnosis | Medical Billing and Coding ...  
The official guidelines should be the basis on which all coding and sequencing decisions are made when the codebooks do not provide specific direction through the use of various conventions and notes. These guidelines were approved for use by hospitals/physicians in coding and outpatient services.

ICD-10-CM Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting  
To group diagnoses into the proper DRG, CMS needs to capture a Present on Admission (POA) Indicator for all claims involving inpatient admissions to general acute care hospitals. Use the UB-04 Data Specifications Manual and the ICD-9-CM Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting to facilitate the assignment of the POA indicator for each "principal" diagnosis and "other" diagnoses codes ...

The rule about coding probable, possible and questionable diagnoses did not change with the implementation of ICD-10-CM. A possible, probable, suspected, likely, questionable, or still to be ruled out condition can be coded if still documented as such at the time of discharge.

It's important to review the official guidelines to determine whether encounter codes (e.g., encounter for palliative care) are appropriate to use as principle (first-listed only), secondary (must have another code listed as the principle), or either designation.

2018 ICD-10-CM Guidelines  
The inpatient guidelines are for hospital coding. Therefore, in the outpatient settings do not code diagnoses documented as "probable," "suspected," "questionable," "rule out," or "working diagnosis."

ICD-10-CM POA Reporting Guidelines  
Inpatient Coding The Inpatient Prospective Payment System (IPPS) is the reimbursement methodology used by healthcare providers and government programs to provide reimbursement for hospital inpatient services based on the patient's diagnosis and treatment provides during his/her hospitalization.
