This dentist diagnoses, treats, and manages your overall oral health care needs, including gum care, root canals, fillings, crowns, veneers, bridges, and preventive education. All practicing general dentists have earned either a DDS or DMD degree (doctor of dental surgery or doctor of dental medicine, respectively).

Both of these dental degrees are equivalent, allowing a dentist to "hang out a shingle" to practice general dentistry after passing a state licensing exam. An oral surgeon, though, spends an additional four to six years of in training after dental school, mostly in a hospital-based surgical environment.
