A Beginning Quilter's Guide to Paper Piecing

The quirk about paper piecing is that you must align your fabric on the BACK of the printed template, and then stitch on the lines on the FRONT! When the paper isn't translucent, if you can't see the printed lines from the back when placing your fabric, you'll need a window or a light box.
