Commission of Ohio (PUCO) created the PIPP gas rules in PUCO case Plus number 08-723-AU-ORD. Development created electric PIPP Plus rules in Chapter 122:5-3, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.). A PIPP Plus customer is also required to apply for all public energy assistance and weatherization programs for which he/she is eligible.

PIPP Plus Rules - Ohio Development Services Agency

Regular HEAP is a one time benefit from July 1 - March 31 processed directly by the State of Ohio to assist with heating costs. Qualifications: total household income at or below 175% of the federal poverty guidelines.

Percentage of Income Payment Plan - Duke Energy

PIPP Plus Eligibility Requirements: To be eligible for the PIPP Plus program, a customer must receive his or her primary or secondary heat source from a company regulated by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO), must have a total household income which is at or below 150 percent of the federal poverty level, and must apply for all energy assistance programs for which he or she is eligible.

Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)

Ohioans with a household income at or below 175 percent of the federal poverty guidelines that are facing disconnection, have been disconnected or have less than a 25 percent supply of bulk fuel in their tank are eligible for the program.

The Percentage of Income Payment Plan, PIPP Plus, helps make monthly payments more affordable on a year-round basis. And, when a PIPP Plus household pays the monthly PIPP Plus payment on-time and in-full, some of their old debt and the rest of that month's bill goes away in the form of a credit on their utility account.

Payment Assistance - AEP Ohio

A household applying for HEAP must report total gross household income for the past 30 days (12 months preferred) for all members, except wage or salary income earned by dependent minors under 18 years old.

Pip Guidelines Ohio

The Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP) helps eligible Ohioans manage their energy bills year-round. Payments are based on a percentage of household income and are consistent year-round. If your home is heated with gas, you will have a monthly payment of 6% of your household income for your natural gas bill, and 6% of your household income for your electric bill.
