Indicated prevention is specifically for high risk individuals who are showing early symptoms of the problem (e.g., a program for girls with body image or eating concerns). A universal prevention program for delivery in co-educational early high school classes that had particular promising outcomes is a media literacy program, MediaSmart (Wilksch & Wade, 2009).
