The basic format for an in-text citation is: Title of the Book (Author Last Name, year).

When a book, paper, or article has no identifiable author, cite it as Anon. Year, e.g., (Anon. 1996) (Anon. is the abbreviation for anonymous). See Full Citation. If you want reference a paper found in another article, do so as follows: (Driblick 1923, in Oobleck 1978).

To cite a paper APA style, start with the author's last name and first initial, and the year of publication. Then, list the title of the paper, where you found it, and the date that you accessed it. In paper, use a parenthetical reference with the last name of the author and the publication year.

A general rule of thumb is that within the text of a paper, italicize the title of complete works but put quotation marks around titles of parts within a complete work. How to Reference Books and Articles in Text Before computers, we used typewriters to underline book titles, and we placed quotation marks around article titles. However, many current style manuals recommend italicizing book titles and magazine names (impossible to do on a typewriter) and using quotation marks around articles.

To cite a research paper in-text in APA, name the author in the text to introduce the quote and put the publication date for the text in parentheses. At the end of your quote, put the page number in parentheses. If you don't mention the author in your prose, include them in the citation.

Note where you got the information within the actual text. You will need to cite the textbook next to information you use from it within the text of your paper. Introduce the author or authors the sentence. One way to cite a textbook in APA format is to introduce the author in the sentence. Use the last name only.

Citations of books in your Reference List should begin with the last name of the book's author, then the author's initials. Next, write the year of publication within parentheses. After the year, list the title of the book in sentence case -- only capitalize the first word of the title and subtitle, if applicable, just as if you were writing a sentence.
