Daily Journal of the Teaching Experience

Reflection Journals: A reflection journal allows instructors to capture details of their teaching directly after class, and read an ongoing narrative of their teaching across terms and years. Taking 5 minutes after class, the instructor writes thoughts on the day's lesson (typing or handwriting works, although handwriting often supports better memory and reflection).

Reflective Teacher Journal

Reflective journals are notebooks that students use when writing about their own thoughts. This encourages the development of metacognitive skills by helping students sort what they know from what they don't know.

a reflective teacher involves moving beyond a primary concern with instructional techniques and "how to" questions and asking "what" and "why" questions that regard instructions and managerial decisions as ends in themselves, but as part of broader educational purposes.
