Pathways To Prevent Domestic Violence

6.26.7.4 Relapse Prevention. Relapse prevention is based on and adapted from the relapse prevention model developed by Marlatt (1985) for alcoholics. The possibility of relapsing is always discussed with the participants. They learn to become aware of high risk situations (present or past) and the reasons why people return to gambling.
