Revit Guide Grids  
Click View tab Sheet Composition panel (Guide Grid). In the Assign Guide Grid dialog, select Create new, enter a name, and click OK. Click and drag the extent controls to specify the extents of the guide grid. The default guide grid extents match the sheet extents plus an offset.

Align Views on a Sheet | Revit Products | Autodesk ...  
By default, Guide Grid is a non-printable element in Revit; however, in this case, Revit will treat it as a visible element. Therefore, it was included as part of the view in the sheet. The solution is easy, all you need to do is to go to the properties of the sheet, set the "Guide Grid" back to <None>.

Revit OpEd: Guide Grids and Positioning Views on Sheet  
A Guide Grid is a customizable grid, available in Revit sheets, to assist the user in aligning specific points of the view among numerous sheets. You can create a Guide Grid for a sheet view under View > Guide Grid. When moving a viewport datum's inside the view or the crop region of the viewport will automatically snap to the Guide Grid.

Revit 2013 Guide Grid  
Revit has a tool for this called the Guide Grid. It is a slightly odd little tool that allows you to line up model elements in the same location across multiple sheets. It does this by allowing you to move the viewport on a sheet by snapping to the datum elements in your model (levels, column grids and reference planes) and then snapping them to the intersections on the Guide Grid.

Guide Grids - Revit Forum  
If you have multiple Guide Grids defined you cannot purge them, and they don't show up in the project browser. They simply exist in the sheet view(s). What is even odder is what this behavior implies. A guide grid is effectively an instance of a datum object similar to Grids, Levels or Reference Planes.
