Each hospital's Patient Safety Score, based on the four remaining PSI measures, will receive the same 5 percent weight as it did last year in the overall scoring methodology in 12 specialties.

### Hospital Safety Scores - PubMed Central (PMC)

In March 2008, data from the Hospital Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (HCAHPS) survey, also known as the CAHPS Hospital Survey, was added to Hospital Compare. HCAHPS provides a standardized instrument and data collection methodology for measuring patient's perspectives on hospital care.
