Advice for schools to develop a sun safety policy. Year-round sun protection is important for children in Queensland, as the UV Index is typically at damaging levels even during winter.. Children and young people's skin is very susceptible to UVR damage and sustaining five or more severe sunburns in this critical period more than double melanoma risk.
