Beginners Lessons in Tabla playing - David Bruce

The tabla consists of two separate wooden drums, one smaller and one larger. The smaller drum, positioned on the right, is called the *daya* (or *tabla*) and the larger drum, positioned on the left, is called the *baylan*.

Tabla, pair of small drums fundamental (since the 18th century) to Hindustani music of northern India, Pakistan, and Bangladesh. The higher pitched of the two drums, which is played with the right hand, is also referred to individually as the *tabla* or as the *daya* (*dahina* or *daya* meaning "right").
