Tesseract. The tesseract is the hypercube in , also called the 8-cell or octachoron. It has the Schläfli symbol, and vertices. The figure above shows a projection of the tesseract in three-space (Gardner 1977). The tesseract is composed of 8 cubes with 3 to an edge, and therefore has 16 vertices, 32 edges, 24 squares, and 8 cubes. It is one of the six regular polychora.
