The letters were indeed originally omitted from the sample alphabet, printed in a western-style serif font, presented in Peter's edict, along with the letters з (replaced by s), и , and Ѡ (the diacriticized letter ѣ was also removed), but were reinstated except ѣ and Ѡ under pressure from the Russian Orthodox Church in a later variant of the modern typeface (1710).
