The original Egyptian name for the text, transliterated *rw nw prt m hrw* , [2] is translated as Book of Coming Forth by Day [3] or Book of Emerging Forth into the Light .

The Egyptian Book of the Dead is not, in fact, a single book, but a collection of scrolls and other documents which include rituals, spells, and prayers found in the ancient Egyptian religion. Because this was a funerary text, copies of the various spells and prayers were often entombed with the dead at the time of burial.

Definition. The Egyptian Book of the Dead is a term coined in the nineteenth century CE for a body of texts known to the Ancient Egyptians as the Spells for Going Forth by Day. After the Book of the Dead was first translated by Egyptologists, it gained a place in the popular imagination as the Bible of the Ancient Egyptians.
