Inca Trail Day 1: The road from Cusco to Km82. Travelers are collected early from their hotels (5:30am) and travel by bus, through the picturesque villages of Chinchero, Urubamba and Ollantaytambo, for the 3 hour scenic trip to kilometer 82 (the start of the trail).

### **Inca Trail (Machu Picchu) - 2020 All You Need to Know ...**

The Inca Trail elevation varies significantly and people often struggle with altitude sickness, especially if they have not spent much time in Cusco before trekking the trail. Cusco stands at 3,200 metres and is already significantly higher than Machu Picchu itself, though many sections of the Inca Trail are much higher. Starting at 2,600 metres, the trail ascends to 3,300 metres on the first day. The second day ascends over Dead Woman's pass- the highest point on the Inca Trail ...
