The crime of obscenity is the intentional: (1) Exposure of the genitals, pubic hair, anus, vulva, or female breast nipples in any public place or place open to the public view, or in any prison or jail, with the intent of arousing sexual desire or which appeals to prurient interest or is patently offensive.

Laws Prohibiting Obscenity. Constitution of India:- Article 19 (2) of the Indian Constitution provides that the state has the power to impose reasonable limitations on freedom of expression to maintain morality and decency. Also, In the case of Ranjit Udeshi v. State of Maharastra (AIR 1965 SC 881), the Court interpreted the word "obscene" as offensive to modesty or decency.
