"The number given [by TSA] is what the whole body receives on average. However, the whole body isn't actually receiving the radiation exposure. The skin on the scalp receives 20 times the average dose that is typically quoted by TSA and throughout the industry. It's still a low dose, but it's much more than what's usually said."

By 2010, it had implemented two new types of full-body scanners. One of these, called a millimeter-wave scanner, uses radio waves to search for hidden weapons or devices.

TSA justifies its use of full-body scanners at airport checkpoints as "the most effective and least intrusive" way to search travelers for weapons hidden under their clothes.

The full body pat down is a manual screening by a TSA agent of the flyer's gender and is intended to ensure that a traveler is not carrying contraband aboard an aircraft. While some pat-downs take place in public areas, flyers can request a pat-down to take place in a private room.
