A player posts scores along with the appropriate USGA Course Rating, Slope Rating, and date of each score to make up the scoring record.

If you shot a 100 on a course that was a par of 72, your handicap would be 28. The USGA Handicap System. The USGA dictates that in order to find the most accurate handicap of a golfer is to have a minimum of 12 established rounds of golf. The best and worst rounds are typically discarded to find the most adequate representation of your skills.
