The seller and the purchaser are liable for the payment of the amount of shortfall of Vehicle Licence Duty to the extent of the amount understated, together with a penalty of 100% of that Duty. If the vehicle has optional number plates fitted, you must also transfer the ownership of the Right to Display entitlement.

The DMV will need these items to transfer ownership of a vehicle to your name: California Certificate of Title (Pink Slip) or Application for Duplicate or Paperless Title (REG 227) if the title is lost. Signature(s) of seller(s) and lienholder, if any, on the Certificate of Title.

What Constitutes a Change in Ownership? Any change of the registered owner or lienholder (legal owner) of a vehicle or vessel is considered to be a change in ownership that must be updated on the records within 10 days of the event at the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). The change is usually due to: Sale, gift, or donation.

Step 2: Complete the Notification of change of ownership vehicle licence transfer (MR9) form. Complete the transfer form (MR9) with the purchaser (buyer) as it needs to be completed by both the seller and the purchaser at the time of sale.

The notification of change of ownership (NCO) is the official document used to transfer ownership of a vehicle in South Africa. Whenever a vehicle is sold, an NCO form must be furnished to the Motor vehicle registering authority with a copy of the sellers ID, the buyers ID and buyers proof of address.

If you've bought a vehicle with cancelled registration and you want to use it on the road, you need to take several steps first, including inspection, certification, reregistration, licensing and the issuing of plates and labels.

A notice of change of ownership must be submitted whenever a vehicle is sold or gifted. The vehicle registration system is updated with the details of the new owner of the vehicle. Please send us the following: - Identity Document of the buyer (person receiving the vehicle) - Identity Document of the seller (person who is relinquishing the vehicle)

Buying a vehicle. As the buyer, you need to complete the changeover at your local PostShop. If the seller has lost their certificate of registration, you can fill out a form (MR13B) at your local PostShop. Once complete the buyer will need a copy of the transfer receipt for proof of the change of ownership. Vehicle road user charges

Changing Vehicle Ownership Checklist

Change owner or title holder particulars for a vehicle. Any changes to the particulars of the vehicle owner or title holder must be communicated to the appropriate registering authority within 21 days after such change. Use the notification of change of address or particulars of person or organisation (NCP) form.

It's the buyer's responsibility to pay for the change of ownership so before they come to pick up the car, make sure they bring their credit or debit card to pay the change of ownership fee. Before the sale of the vehicle has been completed, the seller should ask to see proof that the buyer has completed the required sections to confirm the change of ownership.
