To exit a Guided Access session you must triple click the Home Button, enter your passcode (or use Touch ID) and tap End. You'll also want to set whether the device can go to sleep during a session.

Use Guided Access with iPhone, iPad, and iPod touch - Set up Guided Access Go to Settings > General > Accessibility > Guided Access. Turn on Guided Access. Tap Passcode Settings, then tap Set Guided Access Passcode. Enter a passcode, then reenter it.
