In 1789, Blake printed the first few copies of *The Songs of Innocence* and, in 1794, he bound these together with more illuminated plates and titled the work *The Songs of Innocence and Experience: shewing two sides of the human soul*. Blake therefore declared his interest in duality on the very first page of the 1794 edition.
